




HOW DID MY CHILD PERFORM OVERALL ON THE ELA INNOVATIVE **ASSESSMENT THIS YEAR?**

At the top of each report is information about your child's overall performance, which includes

- overall achievement level
- overall scale score
- the type of support your child will need based on their performance on the test




A chart at the bottom of the report outlines what each of the achievement levels means in terms of how well your child met the expectations for that grade.

(5	Advanced (785 - 850)	Exceeded Expectations
(4	Mastery (750 - 784)	Met Expectations
(3	Basic (725 - 749)	Nearly Met Expectations
(2	Approaching Basic (700 - 724)	Partially Met Expectations
	1	Unsatisfactory (650 - 699)	Expectations Not Met

Performance is also broken down into reporting categories, as shown in the example below.

In each reporting category, your child is provided with a description of performance in the specific area and the support needed moving forward.





HOW SHOULD THESE RESULTS BE USED?

The scores and ratings may be used to help teachers identify students who need additional support or more challenging work. The information will also be used to measure how well schools and school systems are helping students achieve higher expectations.

As a parent, you can use the test results to guide a discussion with your child's teacher(s) about additional supports or enrichment that may be needed in class and at home.

HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTED QUESTIONS TO ASK WHEN DISCUSSING THE RESULTS WITH YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER(S):

- In what areas is my child doing well and in what areas does my child need improvement?
- → What can be done in the classroom to help improve my child's area(s) of weakness?
- → What can be done to appropriately challenge my child in areas where expectations have been exceeded?
- → How can I help support my child's learning
- How do we ensure that my child continues to progress?
